## What does my financial contribution support?

The following financial information is presented to enable you to understand the needs of our parish and to help you determine how you might pledge your treasure.

The 2024 Budget Draft will be distributed for review on November 19 for our Annual Parish Meeting scheduled for December 3, 2023, after the Divine Liturgy. The Budget provides for the needs and goals for the coming year in these broad categories: Fair Share of Diocesan Expenses, Compensation & Payroll, Necessities of Parish Life, Physical Necessities, Maintenance & Improvements, Church Growth & Development, Wider Church Life, and Contingencies. These items enable our parish not to just keep the doors open, but to flourish and accomplish great things, like those highlighted in the opening letter.

The Parish Council, in preparing the 2024 Budget, has identified several physical projects needing priority in the next year: investigate dome for possible leakage; restore the mosaic above the front doors and install a canopy over it; repair downstairs foyer; upgrade kitchen; and refresh bathrooms.

Parish investment income and fundraisers provide an estimated \$19,000. We rely on the stewardship of members like you to fund an estimated \$170,000 of these necessities of parish life.
